Dear Parent/Guardian:

- Upon arrival, students are to go directly to their homerooms to meet their teacher to prepare for the performance.
- We ask that parents go to the gym to find a seat. Please do not go to your child's classroom.
- Any younger siblings in attendance are to remain with a parent. No children in the aisle or running around in the lobby.
- During the performance, please keep the aisles clear for our performers.
- At the end of the performance, a parent should go to his/her child/ren's homeroom to collect your child/ren.

This afternoon is a rehearsal and show just for students. It is not open for people to attend.

Moms- mark your calendars for May 14. It is Moms and Muffins! We will be recognizing you at the 8:15 School Mass, and members of Student Council will pass out treats at the conclusion of Mass.

Our May Crowning and 8th grade Ribbon Ceremony will take place on Tuesday, May 7 at 8:15 a.m. Graduates will wear their graduation gowns (no caps) and First Communicants will wear their First Communion attire. All are invited.

Athletic Program

- If a student athlete is not in school he/she may not play in a game or practice on any day that he/she is not in school.
- Athletes must have a current physical on file. (He/she may not practice or play until the current physical is on file.)
