## Parent(s):

If your child is e-learning or attending in-person instruction, and is in Kindergarten or 6<sup>th</sup> grade, a state physical form is required for attendance. A State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form must be turned in by tomorrow or your child will be excluded from school until we get this paperwork. This is a requirement of the State of Illinois.

We have new guidelines from the Archdiocese of Chicago regarding sending home a child who exhibits symptoms that could be Covid related. If we send a student home due to symptoms, anyone else who lives in that household must go home as well. We have had some cases of a child coming to the office telling us that they were told by a parent. "If you don't feel well, I will come and pick you up." If you feel your child is ill, please keep the child home. If you are calling school and leaving a voice message or emailing to let us know that your child will not be attending school, please make sure to state the reason for the absence.

Picture Day is on Monday. Students do not have to wear uniforms for pictures, but all clothing needs to be appropriate. Please see the Out of Uniform guidelines below. Due to Covid, all ordering and payment will be done online. Photographers will be 6 ft. from the students and social distancing will be followed. We anticipate that the process will take longer than in past years. See the attached for ordering. E-learners are welcome to come in and have their picture taken. Please call the office for a specific time. There is a possibility that pictures will be taken outside.

On Tuesday, you may have noticed the blue and white ribbons that are tied around the trees on the school ground. These ribbons came with the following message for the staff: "The ribbons are a visible reminder to all that the staff at QR is greatly appreciated and supported. These ribbons tie the QR community together and represent unity, strength and appreciation for all your efforts. Let these ribbons continue to demonstrate your strength to meet the challenge and our commitment to follow the guidelines and support you." Thank you, McCormick family!

Please remember that your child's mask may not have a vent.

The school is required to send out a year notification letter regarding asbestos content and management plan. As required, the school retains Intertek-PSI to conduct an AHERA three year re-inspection. Additionally, reports are filed with the Archdiocese three times a year. The letter can be found here.

#### Clarifications/Previous Information

The **Handbook has been updated** and can be found **here**. Please note the changes in green due to COVID-19, and the highlighted areas.

Gym clothes need to be in good repair throughout the year. Students are not to have holes/tears in their clothing. The uniform shirt for gym is gray, not blue.

If you arrive after 7:55 a.m., and there is not a teacher/staff member at the door, you will need to come to door 1. Please do not drop your child/ren at another door after 7:55 a.m.

### . Out of Uniform Days

Spirit days and Out of Uniform days are held at periodic times and for special occasions. Students are expected to dress modestly and appropriately even when out of uniform. Halter tops, spaghetti straps, and midriff style tops are not allowed. **Tank tops and inappropriate t-shirts are not acceptable for any student.** Shorts and/or skirts may not be shorter than mid-thigh. Yoga pants and pajama bottoms (QR pajama pants are allowed) are not acceptable attire. Leggings are permitted with a tunic top. Out of uniform passes are not to be used on days we attend mass.

- Shoes may be dress shoes or athletic shoes. Sandals, clogs, backless, and platform shoes are not permitted. All shoes must be fully enclosed and completely laced.
- A parent will be called if a student comes to school inappropriately dressed, and the student will be expected to change before returning to class.

E-Learners are expected to be engaged in learning activities throughout the school day and comply with the following requirements during all Sessions:

- All students must be dressed appropriately for school during the Session. Refer to handbooks for out of uniform days. I encourage you to have your child wear a school shirt.
- Students need to be seated at a desk/table/appropriate work area during a Session. (Not in or on a bed.)
- All books and materials must be at the designated learning area and readily available during a Session.
- No eating or drinking while in a Session.
- Prior to joining a Session, ensure that your student is in a private location and that his or her device is not visible to the public.
- Log in with first name and last initial for the Session.
- Keep video on during the Session.
- A virtual background may be used, but it must be appropriate and not switched during the lesson.
- Please minimize all background noise and activity during the Session. We want these Sessions to maximize student learning.
- Any misconduct during the Session will be subject to discipline according to the Queen of the Rosary Student Code of Conduct and Discipline Policy.
